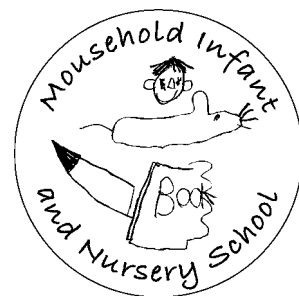

**Exciting News about changes to our Nursery Admissions September 2018**

We are expecting lots of interest in Nursery for Sept 2018 in light of our changes so please register your interest at the school office as soon as you can.

- Nursery sessions will be **8:30am - 11:30** (morning session) and **12:00 - 3:00pm** (afternoon session)
- Those who are eligible for 15hrs (funded by Govt) will be able to select any 5 sessions and will not be tied to all morning sessions or all afternoon sessions (eg: 2.5 days)
- The family will need to fund the cost of the lunch time supervision period if the child is staying all day. This will cost £2 per day (home packed lunch to be provided).
