Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope you all had an enjoyable half-term and enjoyed the lovely weather. The children have settled back into school really well and seem to have grown over the holiday! This is an exciting few weeks for them when they begin to prepare for their next year group. We always plan transition very carefully and ensure that all staff who work with your children communicate with their new class staff. Our Covid Risk Assessment with bubbles of children is still in place so that makes it a bit trickier for children to move around school to their new classroom to have a look, but we will do the best we can to make it work. We will inform you of your child's new class and teacher next week. Like I said in the last newsletter, we will have one less class in September and the mobile classroom will be used for Nurture groups and intervention work. The children will be in a class with some of their friends. We have thought carefully about the mixings and we very much appreciate you putting your trust in us to get it right. After a year of only being allowed to mix with children in their bubble it will be lovely for them to get to know other children too and hopefully by the time September comes we won't have a bubble system. But we will continue to follow the guidance accordingly. It might be something we don't know until a few weeks before the start of September.

This is a combination of dance, acrobatics and music. It is quite complex and you will be very impressed!

Each week we will update you on some aspect of our curriculum. This week it’s all about RSHE – (Relationships, Sex and Health Education.)

Thank you to all the parents who came along to the information session on zoom. Also, all of you who have read the policy and information on the website and that was sent to you.

We have recently begun our new statutory RSHE lessons. There are 6 lessons in total for Reception, Year 1 and 2. We are using the Educator Solutions resources. The lessons follow the same format, though cover more information as the children get older. The sequence of lessons is as follows:

1. *My feelings*
2. *My body*
3. *My relationships*
4. *My beliefs*
5. *My rights and responsibilities*
6. *Asking for help*

Both Reception and Year 1 have had the first lessons and the feedback has been very positive. The teachers have found the resources interesting, useful and attractive for the children to access. The children have been very respectful and sensitive, with their observations and questions. Hopefully these lessons and the Top Tips leaflet will make it easier for you to talk to your child about this important topic.

Summer Swim 2021

Swan Summer Swim Courses are suitable for children aged 4 years and over. The intensive courses are an ideal opportunity for children to top up their skills or start learning to swim during the school holidays in a fun and safe environment.

All of our lessons are taught by Swim England qualified swimming teachers and are based on the national plan for teaching Swimming as recommended by Swim England. As per Swim England guidelines, all involved adults have a current DBS check and safeguarding training.

Lessons are £35 for a 5-day course. (Prices are per swimmer. The lessons cannot be split between siblings etc). **Bookings are non-refundable unless the course has to be cancelled by Norwich Swan.**

Week 2 – Monday 2nd August to Friday 6th August

Week 3 – Monday 9th August to Friday 13th August

Week 4 – Monday 16th August to Friday 20th August

Course Information:

- Beginners range from no swimming ability up to 10m swimming (stages 1-3).
- Improvers (working on stages 4-6) can swim at least 10m on front & back or have passed stage 3.
- Beginners will swim widths; Improvers will swim lengths.
- All lessons are 30 minutes long.

Changing Rooms:

Use of the changing rooms will depend on COVID rules at the time of the course.

Where changing rooms are being used: If a child is of an age where help is required from a parent, then the parent/guardian must use the correct changing room for their own sex/gender and their child should accompany them. Once children are aged 8, we expect them to change unassisted without parents in the changing rooms. This is for the privacy of older children who may feel uncomfortable with adults present.

If a child requires additional specific assistance this should be addressed with the teacher at the start of the course.

Please refrain from taking any photographs in the pool and changing areas. Mobile phones should remain in bags or pockets or have the camera function disabled.
